



**Bring all of the colors of the rainbow
together in a spinning wheel of color. Spin
fast—or slowly! Experiment with colors.**

Trace a paper plate or a dinner plate onto cardboard with a pencil. Use scissors to carefully cut out the circle. With a ruler, draw lines to divide the circle into eight sections, like a pie.

Color each section differently. Have a parent poke a hole in the middle of the circle.

Take a piece of twine, or string about 28 inches long. Run the rope through the holes and tie a knot.

Take a piece of rope in each hand with the circle in the middle and go in circles to get the rope twisted.

No Bake Peanut Butter Balls

Ingredients

- 1 cup creamy peanut butter
- 1 1/4 cup non-fat powdered milk
- 1/2 cup honey

Mix ingredients in a medium size bowl. Put mixture and bowl in refrigerator for 1 hour. Then take out and roll balls to a 1" ball. Let dry on wax paper. Store balls in the refrigerator to keep firm. Enjoy!!

EASY PAPER BUTTERFLIES




Equipment

Paper—6" square—one for each butterfly
Scissors
String for hanging

Instructions

1. Cut the square paper in half
2. Take one piece and fold it in half length ways
3. Open it up and fold in the 4 corners to meet the central fold, so you have a rectangle with pointy ends
4. Now you need to fold the paper in accordion style and then fold in half
5. Now take the second strip of your origami paper and start folding it into an accordion style across the short width. Fold in half
6. Tie with a ribbon or thread and secure. You are finished.
